Internship description:

The internship will be 10 hours per week, unpaid, highly driven, independent remote work. Guidance will be provided with high likelihood of publishing research in peer-reviewed journal article/s.

Key Projects:

- Conduct literature review on gender equity, women's health and human rights globally, and what works to change norms, and synthesize.
- Conduct literature review on data to action, and what promotes data use among decision-makers at policy and systems change, communities, and public. How to increase awareness and influence change re: equity and key public health issues. Assist with preparing manuscripts and grant proposal.
- Develop material/lit review on positive youth development and resilience - develop data collection tools, assist with data collection, qualitative analysis

Qualifications:

- Some research experience, conducting literature reviews, reviewing articles and synthesizing into peer-reviewed papers.
- Strong interest in serving ethnically-diverse, vulnerable populations and impacting social justice issues locally and globally.

- Strong written and verbal communication skills.
