### Internship Description:

We are looking for highly driven, results-oriented equity-focused graduate students, preferably MPH or PhD students, in Public Health, Epidemiology, Criminal Justice, Education, Psychology or related field, who have some understanding of epidemiological study designs, strong quantitative analysis skills, and ability to conduct and synthesize literature reviews. Strong quantitative data analysis and report writing, evaluation courses and some experience in program evaluation, data collection and tools development a plus. We are looking for innovative, fast learners, who are responsible, independent critical thinkers. Subject matter knowledge in gender and racial/cultural equity, maternal and child health, restorative justice, violence prevention, youth development, social determinants of health and organizational development theory/systems change a plus. Hours are flexible, approximately 5-8 hours/ week, remote work. Great for practicum. Guidance provided with high likelihood of publishing several peer-reviewed journal article/s depending on performance and results. Stipend up to \$1,000 per month with 12-15 hours per week performance, during summer. Hours flexible during school year.

### Key Projects:

- Provide research support (e.g., lit reviews, develop eval plans, logic models, tools, data collection) for existing evaluation projects for foster youth, criminal justice, systems change, mental health and public health.
- Cleaning and analyzing qualitative and/or quantitative data. Some experience and knowledge of public data systems (health, vital statistics, YRBS/BRFS, school administrative is a plus).
- Prepare graphs, synthesize results and write and finalize evaluation reports.
- Prepare manuscripts and manage submission with peer-reviewed journals to ensure timely quality publications. Work on exiting manuscripts, conduct lit reviews in areas of gender equity, MCH, youth development, data to action/evaluation methods.

### Qualifications:

- Strong interest in serving culturally diverse, vulnerable populations and impacting social justice.
- Strong data analysis skills, in SAS/STATA or SPSS. Cleaning, merging, coding and analyzing including multi-level modeling /HLM and descriptive analysis (plus)
- Advanced Epi methods with ability to conduct systematic literature reviews, comparing findings and synthesizing results into a manuscript.
- Sufficient subject matter expertise in related areas (youth development, justice systems change, social determinants of health, violence prevention, mental health)
- Some practice experience with county/nonprofit a plus.
